Breakfast: A variety of cereals and toast are offered daily. A variety of dairy free, egg free and gluten free options are available daily.

Lunch (Vacation Care): Our Vacation Care menu offers a range of hot and cold dishes, to give our children the energy they need for an active day. These meals may include but are not limited to spaghetti bolognese, fried rice, butter chicken, pasta salad etc. A variety of dairy free, egg free and gluten free options are also made available.

Afternoon Tea: Afternoon tea is served to children upon arrival at ROSHCA. A selection of fruit, vegetables and sandwiches are available daily, with an additional 'special' available 2-3 afternoons per week.

Absences

Please note: If your child is absent from school you will need to advise Roshca or you will be charged a non-notification fee. This can be done either via the OWNA app or by sending us an email. Due to privacy reasons the school are unable to provide us with this information.

Program

Our educational program is flexible and engaging, with free movement between multiple areas including both indoor and outdoor play. Structured sports and craft activities are provided daily and facilitated by educators, while the remainder of the program is child led, with resources stored in a way that is accessible to children.

We have a Prep Integration Program which is designed to help the new students transition from class to Roshca by having 2 Educators collect your child from the Prep Areas and bring them over to Roshca for some afternoon tea and some child led play.

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) Families may be eligible for CCS, which will reduce your out of pocket childcare costs. CCS payments are paid directly to ROSHCA, who will pass this on to parents as a fee reduction.
